5 MINUTE MOVES

Balloon Bounce

A fun and active way to move and laugh together!

Try a balloon bounce challenge to get the body moving and build coordination. You'll need a balloon and a little space to play. The goal is to keep the balloon from touching the ground while bouncing it back and forth.

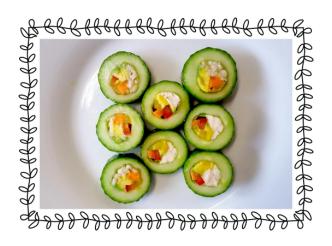
Set up a play area, and let your child know that they need to keep the balloon in the air by tapping it with their hands. Explain that they can't use their feet and have to stay in the designated space. You can add extra challenges, like bouncing the balloon between two people or using only one hand. You can make it even more fun by trying to keep a rhythm, saying, "Bounce, bounce, tap, tap!" or creating simple rules like no hitting the balloon more than once in a row. Ready? Say: "Let's bounce!" and begin the fun!

KIDS IN THE KITCHEN

CUCUMBER KIMBAP Serves 4–6

INGREDIENTS

- 2 Continental Cucumber
- 100g chicken (cooked and shredded)
- 1/2 avocado
- Vegetables of choice (cut into strips)



METHOD

1. Cut whole cucumber into 3 chunks

2. Use the end of a teaspoon to hollow out cucumber seeds / core

3. In a small bowl mash chicken and avocado together

4. Spoon a small amount of the chicken mixture into each cucumber tube and compress down to one side

5. Insert the vegetable strips until the tube is full

6. Cut into small rounds to serve
